

Children's Chapel is a wonderful opportunity for children ages 3 through 1st grade to learn about worship and begin hearing stories from the Bible. In chapel we learn about how to listen and talk with God, we listen to and discuss stories from the Old Testament as well as learn about Jesus and his teachings in the New Testament. We end chapel with singing and by sharing the Peace with one another. Parents can look for a take home sheet to help encourage ongoing discussions of the lesson at home.

There are plenty of opportunities for parents and members of our congregation to get involved with Children's Chapel. We need a volunteer to lead chapel each week. All the lessons and materials are emailed to you prior to your Sunday so you are all ready to go. If you are interested, there is a sign up sheet in the parish hall.

We also invite parents to explore Chapel with your children either before or after church. We have many resources to continue ongoing learning at home including children's bibles, stories related to our Children's Chapel lessons, and we even have a fun puzzle that tests your books of the bible knowledge.
